NEW ACADEMIC SESSION: The Dhaka Project School started its new academic session (2009-10) from 1st August 2009. Among 450 registered students of the previous session from Std-I to Std-VI, 412 students attended the Final Exam; 310 students are promoted to new classes. In every session students are evaluated through four quarter exam, along with a half yearly and the final exam. From this Session, The Dhaka Project School is going to follow the English version of National Curriculum (NCTB) for STD-I to STD-VII; earlier the school followed EDEXCEL module.
